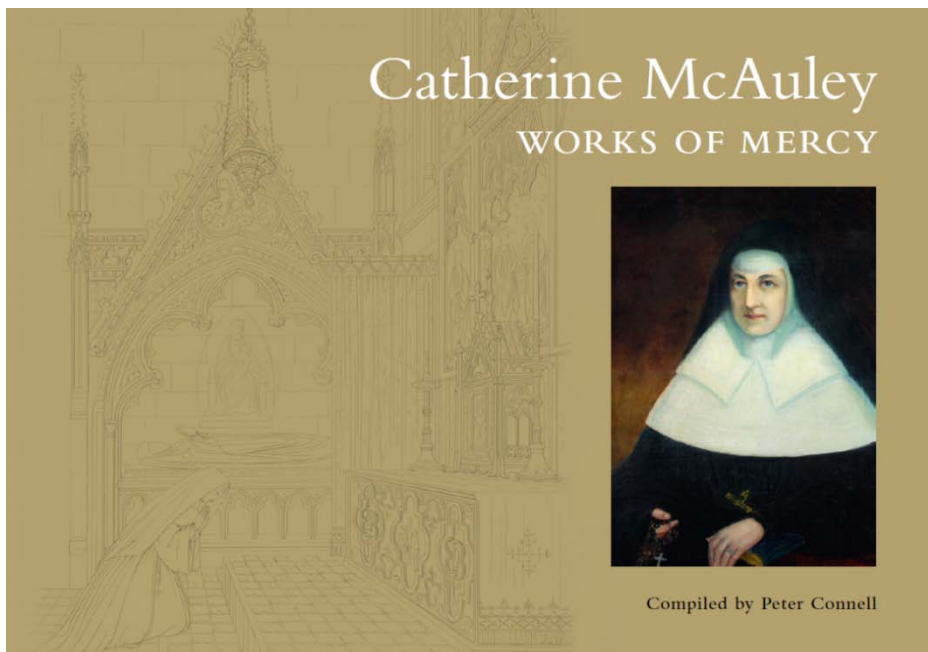


Catherine McAuley: Works of Mercy
